PARISH GROUPING: Progress on Parish Grouping: Joint Vision Group of Kinross and Orwell & Portmoak Church

nt Vision Group of Kinross and Orwell & Portmoak Churc Highlights of 19th June 2024 Meeting

- 1. **Congregational voting** will be taking place in the coming months on the union of Kinross and Orwell & Portmoak and only those who are listed as members on the roll can vote. Adherents are not entitled to vote so would need to become members. You are encouraged to be part of this process, so if you are not sure whether you are on the member roll, please check with your Church Office.
- 2. **Steering Group meeting 2 July 2024** of the Ministers and Session Clerks of Cleish, Fossoway, Orwell & Portmoak and Kinross, looking to Presbytery to clarify how best to progress the unions.
- 3. **Governance**: special meetings of Kirk Sessions to be arranged in second half of July to discuss a structure of eldership and trusteeship proposed by the Vision Group that ensures strong governance.
- 4. **Church magazine:** a proposal to be presented to both September Kirk Sessions for a joint quarterly church magazine circulated to church members, with additional copies as a community outreach tool.
- 5. Next Vision Group meeting: 17th July 2024.

PRESBYTERY OF PERTH:

NEW: Visit Clackmannan Parish Church: This prominent and historic church, whose minister is Rev Austin Wicks, is now open to visitors, over the summer (Tue, Wed and Thu 2pm-4pm). We are invited to pop in and admire the impressive oak panelling, the historic graveyard, and the beautiful stained-glass windows, including the only one in Scotland installed to commemorate the Coronation in 1953.

NEW: Training for Elders: The Presbytery of Perth ran a training evening in three different locations this week for elders on Church law and the responsibilities of elders as Trustees of charities. A number of our elders attended the training in Perth on Tuesday, which was very well attended.

NEW: Service of Union: The Presbytery of Perth will hold a Service of Union on **Tuesday**, **2**nd **July** at Chalmers Ardler Parish Church. This marks the new union between the congregations of Chalmers Ardler and Strathmartine Parish Churches, in north Dundee. It is a further example of the implementation of the Presbytery Mission Plan.

NEWS FROM THE CHURCH OF SCOTLAND:

NEW: Ukrainian Exhibition - Andrea Fraser: Forthview Parish Church (Dalgety Bay, Fife) held a photographic exhibition last week from the Ukrainian group which has been meeting regularly in the church since coming to Scotland two years ago. Rev Andrea Fraser, who came from our congregation and is now a minister working at Forthview, said: "The 14 Ukrainian families who regularly meet in the church have become very much a part of the community. The church gave our Ukrainian friends a safe place to meet and, where possible, we could offer support, such as practical help with form filling or equipping them with clothes or personal items." The church also helped support host families and collected items for a hospital in Ukraine, with the local Ukrainian group helping sort out donations and ensuring they were labelled correctly.
