Sunday, 1st December: On this Advent Sunday we pray: Lord Jesus Christ, You came among us as a child in Bethlehem. Make Your home in our hearts this Christmas – God with us – and bless our community, our nation and our world with the knowledge of Your transforming Light and Peace. Amen.
